#### **CHALLENGE NUMBER TWO:**

Memorize the following Bible verse:

“Do to others as you would have them do to you.”  
Luke 6:31

Lesson 11, “The Golden Rule”, Jesus stated the Golden Rule in the positive form – Luke 6:31. He then takes the Golden Rule one step further as Luke 6:32-35. Explain the meaning of these scriptures in your own word below.

#### **CHALLENGE NUMBER THREE:**

Memorize the following Bible Verse:

Anyone who wants to be first must be the very last, and the servant of all.”  
Mark 9:35b

The lesson aim of Lesson 12 is that students will understand that an essential part of relationships that are pleasing to God is an attitude of service.

After studying Lesson 12 exploring the many scriptures referenced therein, particularly Philippians 2:3-7, explain what our job is as Christians.
